- **Dedicated surgery suites** for soft tissue, neurology, orthopedic, dental, and fluoroscopic-assisted surgeries.

- **24-Hour post-surgery care** supported by our VECCS level 1 emergency and critical care team, including anesthetic monitoring for complete, post-operative care, means you don't have to worry about managing your pet's anesthetic recovery and post-surgical discomfort at home.
- Collaborative patient care with input from other specialty services including cardiology, oncology, internal medicine, and dentistry.
- Tailored pain management plans supported by our cardiology, critical care, and internal medicine departments, ensures your pet's specific anesthesia needs are met and they remain comfortable through the procedure and recovery.
- **Comprehensive follow-up** appointments and radiographs (as needed) are included to track your pet's progress and fine-tune their recovery plan.

Our Surgical Services

We offer a comprehensive range of diagnostic tests and surgical procedures across multiple specialties.

Orthopedic Surgery

Our orthopedic services address joint, bone, and ligament conditions, including:

- Diagnostics: Advanced imaging (MRI, CT, digital X-ray, diagnostic ultrasound, fluoroscopy), lameness evaluations, and joint assessments.
- Procedures such as:
- Treatments for elbow dysplasia, cranial cruciate ligament ruptures (e.g., TPLO, TTA), and patellar luxation.
- Fracture repair using modern internal and external fixation systems.
- Hip dysplasia management, including total hip replacement (THR), triple pelvic osteotomy (TPO), and femoral head ostectomy (FHO).

Neurologic Surgery

We provide solutions for nervous system disorders of the brain and spine, including:


- Diagnostics: Neurologic exams, MRI, CT, myelograms, and MRI, /CT, myelograms, and CSF spinal taps (CSF analysis).
- **Procedures:**
- Spinal surgeries: spinal decompression for intervertebral disc disease and other conditions, spinal fracture management, atlantoaxial stabilization, management of lumbosacral disease.
- Intracranial (brain) surgeries: skull fracture management, Chiari malformation surgery.
- Surgical interventions as part of comprehensive care for tumors of the brain, skull, & spine.
- Nerve & muscle biopsies.















Soft Tissue Surgery

Our general surgery services address conditions involving the head, neck, thoracic, abdominal, and skin structures:

- **Diagnostics:** Ultrasound, on-site imaging (MRI/CT), biopsies, and laparoscopic/thoracoscopic evaluations.
- Procedures such as:
- Head and Neck: Treatment for airway syndromes, ear canal surgeries, and salivary gland issues.
- o **Thoracic:** Lung lobectomies, PDA ligations, and pericardiectomies.
- Abdominal: Gastrointestinal surgeries, liver and gallbladder procedures, and foreign body removal.
- o Skin and Reconstruction: Trauma management, wound reconstruction.
- Surgical oncology options for all surgically managed cancers

Minimally Invasive Surgical Procedures including:

- Arthroscopy, laparoscopy, and thoracoscopy for exploration and biopsies.
- Procedures such as gastropexy, bladder stone removal, and organ biopsies.
- Elective procedures in high anesthetic risk patients.
